

HOW TO USE YOUR MINISTRY BOOKLET

First, be encouraged; God has wonderful things He wants to do through and in you as you serve Him in our Church Family. Expect it as you read through the various ministry opportunities. The Grace Chapel Family believes every member is a minister. That means there's a place of service for you, whatever your gifts or abilities are. Discuss your SHAPE & ministry opportunities with those close to you if you desire their feedback. Seek out more information and answers to any questions you have from the Staff or Ministry Leaders. CAMPUS OPERATIONS

CAMPUS OPERATIONS

The Campus Operations Ministry is designed to ensure that our facilities and property are maintained with a standard of excellence that is worthy of our Lord Jesus Christ. Our mission is to have teams serving together with one heart and purpose to help the ministries at Grace Chapel succeed and to maintain an environment that honors God. We are looking for people who are passionate about using their individual talents to maintain our facilities and grounds with these goals in mind. The Campus Operations Ministry encourages teamwork and spiritual development, not only as we work together, but as we actively pray for the ministry and each other.

BUILDING MAINTENANCE & CONSTRUCTION 1.5 hrs/every other wk

The Building Maintenance Team helps with general maintenance for interior and exterior needs such as painting, plumbing, electrical, heating and various other work projects.

FACILITY SETUP & TEAR DOWN (Event Team) 1 hr/every other wk

This team transforms the facility for all activities and events. This involves the setup and tear down of tables and chairs as requested by a specific ministry and preparing the facility for regular ministry use.

LAWN CARE & LANDSCAPING TEAMS 1 hr/wk

The Lawn Care Team helps with mowing, edging, weed eating and additional lawn care needs. This team also helps to keep the grounds looking manicured throughout the spring and summer by taking on a designated area and keeping it looking its best.

SNOW REMOVAL TEAM as needed

The Snow Removal Team removes snow from sidewalks and parking lots for services and events.

VEHICLE CARE TEAM as needed

This team takes care of all Grace Chapel vehicles' maintenance and appearance.

CAMPUS OPERATIONS

VEHICLE & SMALL ENGINE MAINTENANCE TEAM LEADER as needed

The Vehicle & Small Engine Team Leader is responsible to ensure that all Grace Chapel vehicles and equipment are maintained and repaired.

WEEKEND BUILDING SERVICES 2 times/month First Service

This person is responsible for unlocking doors and checking lights prior to the first service and facilitating any housekeeping issues during the service.

WEEKEND BUILDING SERVICES
Second Service

2 times/month

This person is responsible for unlocking doors and checking lights prior to the second service and facilitating any housekeeping issues during the service.

FLOOR CARE TEAM

1.5 hrs/every other wk

The Floor Care Team will take care of cleaning the carpets and the tile floors.

LEVITE TEAM

1.5 hrs/every other wk

The Levite Team will take care of various housekeeping issues around the church such as cleaning classrooms, dusting, cleaning baseboards, cleaning up after special events and other various duties.

CARE MINISTRY

PRAYER TEAM

We believe that prayer is the key to everything that we do at Grace Chapel. In light of this, prayer teams are vital to our ministry. Each team has one goal in mind – lifting requests before the Throne of Grace. A portion of the ministry includes organizing special times and days of prayer throughout the year.

PRAYER TEAM COORDINATOR **2 hrs/wk**

The Prayer Team Coordinator will organize and oversee the church prayer teams.

PRAYER GATHERINGS TEAM MEMBER **1.5 hrs/wk**

The Prayer Gatherings Team Member will meet with the prayer team on the 3rd Sunday of each month to pray for the church, specific needs of our people and general prayer requests.

SUNDAY PRAYER TEAM MEMBER **1.5 hrs/wk**

The Sunday Prayer Team Member will pray with those in need between and after services on Sunday Mornings as scheduled. This role includes personal interaction with members of the church.

HEARTS & HANDS

The Hearts & Hands Team seeks to be the hands of the Grace Chapel Body by providing meals. We believe that through this ministry we can encourage one another by serving those in our church family during their times of need.

HEARTS & HANDS COORDINATOR – MEAL **1-2 hrs/as needed**

The Hearts & Hands Coordinator is responsible for the planning and coordination of meals for the individuals and families after the birth of a baby, illness or in other times of need.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Children are very important to Jesus. During His earthly ministry, He was never too busy to stop and spend time with them. Jesus realized the value of children. Here at Grace Chapel, we view children the same way; we are never too busy to stop and spend time with them.

SUNDAY MORNING

TEACHER

2 services/month

The Teacher is responsible for overseeing or coordinating all activities during their time together with the help of the Teacher's Helper. They are responsible for sharing God's love and teaching His Word to children through a variety of methods. Classes include Nursery/Toddlers, Preschool, and Pre-K & Kindergarten.

TEEN FLOATER

2 services/month

The Teen Floater is responsible for helping keep order among the children in the Ministry and for providing hands-on assistance in a designated area under the direction of the Teacher. As a Teen Floater, you will have the opportunity to work with various classrooms and teachers.

TEACHER'S HELPER

2 services/month

The Teacher's Helper is responsible to minister to the children under the direction of the Teacher. They are to provide hands-on assistance in the classroom and to help provide both a fun and safe environment for the children.

SUNDAY MORNING CHILDREN'S CHURCH MINISTRY

As a church, we have the huge responsibility of providing opportunities for children to learn about God's love for them and how He wants them to live. That is why each weekend we are dedicated to teaching our kids the Word of God in Children's Church. Every Sunday they have a great time singing songs, participating in exciting activities and listening to an important Bible story that will help them discover who God is and how they should respond to His truth. Classes include Grades 1 – 4.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

CHILDREN'S CHURCH TEACHER **2 services/month
or a 4-6 wk series**

The Children's Church Teacher is responsible to oversee or coordinate all Children's Church Helpers. The teacher is responsible to teach weekly lessons, prepare classroom activities and lead the volunteers in the classroom.

CHILDREN'S CHURCH TABLE LEADER **1 year weekly commitment**

The Children's Church Table Leader is responsible to help maintain a positive environment for learning and will assist with miscellaneous duties as needed.

CHILDREN'S CHURCH MUSIC LEADER **2 services/month**

The Children's Church Music Leader leads children through the hand motions from the Hill Song Worship music DVD during their Sunday morning worship time.

CHILDREN'S CHURCH MULTIMEDIA OPERATOR **2 services/month**

The Children's Church Multimedia Operator runs the multimedia for the children's church services.

IGNITE

IGNITE is our midweek discipleship program that meets on Wednesdays from Oct. – Apr. It provides a fun and exciting atmosphere in which to present the gospel, encourage Scripture memorization, and promote Christ-like living and service. IGNITE includes K-5th Grade.

IGNITE DIRECTOR **3 hrs/wk**

IGNITE Director personally oversees all activities, children and volunteers for IGNITE.

GAME HELPER **2 hrs/wk**

The IGNITE Game Helper works with a group of children assisting them in game time throughout the night.

LISTENER **2 hr/wk**

The IGNITE Listener works with a group of children assisting them in Bible memorization and understanding of the scripture they are learning.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

T&T (TRUTH & TRAINING) LEADER **2 hrs/wk**

The T&T Leader works with a group of children (K-5th grade) assisting them in Bible memorization, game time, lesson time, as well as large group and small group activities.

IGNITE WORSHIP LEADER **.5 hrs/wk**

The IGNITE Worship Leader leads the Children in worship on Wednesday night at the beginning of IGNITE.

THE RIDE

Marvel...Discover...Experience!

Back2Back Compass invites students to a weekly "Ride" as we MARVEL at our experiences, DISCOVER relationships, ideas, and TRUTH, while embracing our BEAUTY through creation, laughter, and fun. The Ride is for children entering 1st grade through 6th grade in the Fall and meets every Wednesday in July. The first 50 registrants will be guaranteed a spot. All others will be accepted based on availability.

RIDE GROUP LEADER **6 hrs/wk**

A Ride Group Leader oversees a group of 5-7 students each Wednesday in July as they travel to their weekly activities.

COMMUNITY LIFE

LIFE GROUPS

The purpose of Life Groups is to connect people in small groups that are Christ-centered and relationally rich gatherings, cultivating spiritual growth and true fellowship. Our desire is to see our Church family develop trusting relationships marked by ever increasing authenticity and transparency that fosters real community life.

LIFE GROUP HOST **4-8 hrs/month**

The LIFE Group Host will open their home as a meeting place for a LIFE Group.

LIFE GROUP LEAD TEAM **2 – 3 hrs/wk**

The LIFE Group Lead Team will be relationally connected and accountable to assigned pastoral Staff oversight, helping to connect and integrate the ministry with all of church life.

LIFE GROUP LEADER/FACILITATOR **2 – 3 hrs/wk**

The Life Group Leader/Facilitator will be selected and/or affirmed by both the GC Life Group Leadership Team and the Life Group members themselves. Affirmation will be based upon a leader possessing a sufficient level of observed and referenced maturity in the areas of spiritual life, social skill, and alignment to GC's vision, mission, and values.

WEDNESDAY NIGHT CONNECT

The purpose of our Wednesday Night Connect is to provide opportunities for further study of the Word of God, with a goal toward spiritual growth and maturity for every adult who calls Grace Chapel home. The Wednesday Night Connect also promotes avenues and opportunities for the development of meaningful friendships within the Body in a smaller group of people through LIFE Groups.

COMMUNITY LIFE

WEDNESDAY NIGHT CONNECT GROUP LEADER 2-3 hrs/wk

The Wednesday Night Connect Group Leader will be selected and/or affirmed by both the GC Wednesday Night Connect Leadership Team and the Wednesday Night Connect members themselves. Affirmation will be based upon a leader possessing a sufficient level of observed and referenced maturity in the areas of spiritual life, social skill, and alignment to GC's vision, mission, and values.

WEDNESDAY NIGHT CONNECT FOOD TEAM 30min/wk

The Wednesday Night Connect Food Team is responsible for setting up and cleaning up the food and beverages provided.

LEGACY WOMEN'S MINISTRY

Growing Women in God! The Legacy Women's Ministry of Grace Chapel begins with the basic premise that all women are gifts from God, and all women HAVE gifts that God intends to use for His glory. With that in mind, we seek to help women get connected in meaningful relationships with other women with the specific intent of helping them become more securely established in a meaningful relationship with God. Out of that relationship, we seek to see them become equipped to be a blessing to their families, their friends, their church and ultimately the world. This is accomplished through Bible studies, retreats, and special events that are strategically designed to relate directly to the needs of women in today's culture.

The Legacy Women's Ministry at Grace Chapel is divided into ***Bible Studies*** and ***Special Events***.

BIBLE STUDIES

The Legacy Women's Ministry of Grace Chapel is firmly committed to God's Word and to its study for growing women spiritually. Our goal is to draw out the rich encouragement and life-changing power that is abundantly found in the Word of God to grow women into spiritual maturity.

BIBLE STUDY LEADER 5 hrs/wk

The Bible Study Leader facilitates meaningful Bible Studies.

COMMUNITY LIFE

BIBLE STUDY COMMUNITY LIFE LEADER **1 hr/wk**

The Bible Study Community Life Leader creates a culture of hospitality by welcoming women and contacting them when they miss a meeting by note, phone or email.

BIBLE STUDY PRAYER REQUEST COORDINATOR **1-2 hr/month**

The Bible Study Prayer Request Coordinator collects the prayer requests and email them to the Bible Study Group each week.

BIBLE STUDY CHILDCARE COORDINATOR **1 hr/wk**

The Bible Study Childcare Coordinator coordinates childcare for the mothers that attend the Thursday morning Bible Studies.

BIBLE STUDY CHILDCARE VOLUNTEER **3 hrs/wk**

The Bible Study Childcare Volunteer provides childcare for the mothers who attend the Thursday morning Bible Study.

SPECIAL EVENTS

The Women's Special Events Ministry at Grace Chapel is just that . . . special! Our events are times of delightful refreshment and girlfriend fun that are specifically designed and set apart just for women! It's a chance to come together to be uplifted and encouraged and to grow deeper in our relationship with God, while enjoying relaxing atmospheres and great fellowship. Our special events also generate exciting opportunities to invite those we've been investing in by opening our doors and our hearts to women in the community! We'd love for you and your friends to join us as we share in these special evenings and weekends filled with faith, fun and fellowship!

RETREAT COORDINATOR **as needed**

The Women's Ministry Retreat Coordinator is responsible for coordinating the annual retreat and providing direction to the retreat team for implementation.

COMMUNITY LIFE

RETREAT TEAM **as needed**

The Retreat Team serves in implementing all aspects of the annual retreat.

RETREAT WORSHIP TEAM **as needed**

The Retreat Worship Team provides meaningful worship for the annual retreat.

RETREAT REGISTRATION COORDINATOR **as needed**

The Retreat Registration Coordinator provides direction and organizes, coordinates and oversees the registration process before and at the retreat.

SPECIAL EVENTS REGISTRATION TEAM **as needed**

The Special Events Registration Team assists with registering women prior to a retreat, and checking women in at the retreat, and registering women for special events.

SPECIAL EVENTS PHOTOGRAPHY COORDINATOR **as needed**

The Women's Ministry Special Events Photography Coordinator leads the photography team to take pictures of each event for future promotional purposes.

SPECIAL EVENTS PHOTOGRAPHY TEAM **as needed**

The Special Events Photography Team takes pictures of each event for future promotional purposes.

SPECIAL EVENTS GREETER COORDINATOR **as needed**

The Special Events Greeter Coordinator provides direction, organizes, coordinates and oversees the welcoming of women at each event.

SPECIAL EVENTS GREETER TEAM **as needed**

The Special Events Greeter Team creates a culture of hospitality by welcoming women at each event.

COMMUNITY LIFE

SPECIAL EVENTS FOOD COORDINATOR as needed

The Special Events Food Coordinator provides direction, organizes, coordinates and oversees the food that is needed for each event.

SPECIAL EVENTS FOOD TEAM as needed

The Special Events Food Team organizes and serves the food for each women's event.

SPECIAL EVENTS DECORATIONS COORDINATOR as needed

The Special Events Decorations Coordinator provides direction, organizes, coordinates and oversees the decorating that is needed for each women's event.

SPECIAL EVENTS DECORATIONS TEAM MEMBER as needed

The Special Events Decorations Team assists the Decorations Coordinator in creating, setting up and cleaning up the decorating that is needed for each ladies' event.

SPECIAL EVENTS HOSTESS as needed

The Special Events Hostess opens her home to our women for an evening of fellowship such as Christmas Ornament Exchange, Game Night or Dessert.

MEN'S MINISTRY

At Grace Chapel, we are passionate about helping men to be men and helping men learn how to reflect our real "Father" in Heaven through their personal walk with Christ. We invite you to be a part of the new ministry opportunities for men at Grace Chapel.

BIBLE STUDY LEADER 3-5 hrs/month

The Bible Study Leader facilitates the Wednesday morning Men's Bible study on a rotating schedule.

COMMUNITY LIFE

OPEN GYM COORDINATOR

3 hrs/wk

The Open Gym Coordinator is responsible for overseeing the gym when open for sporting activities and any other gym activities not scheduled by a ministry area.

COLLEGE/YOUNG PROFESSIONAL MINISTRY (608)

608 is a community of college students, young professionals, 18-30 year olds, and coffee lovers centering on the grace of God as we resolve to do justice, love mercy, and walk humbly with God. 608 is a reference to Micah 6:8, "He has showed you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you but to do justice, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God?"

608 LEADERSHIP TEAM – POINT

5-7 hrs/wk

The 608 Leadership Point Person is responsible for planning, organizing, and overseeing the 608 Leadership Team, all college/young professional small groups, and events. The Point Person directly oversees prayer, worship and social teams.

608 SMALL GROUP LEADER

3-5 hrs/wk

The 608 Small Group Leader is responsible for shepherding their 608 LIFE Group and is responsible to watch, oversee, coordinate, teach and minister to the members of the group.

608 EVENTS COORDINATOR

1-2 hrs/wk

The 608 Events Coordinator plans and organizes regular activities for college/young professionals for the purpose of fun, community and spiritual growth.

608 EVENTS TEAM

1-2 hrs/wk

The 608 Events Team assists in planning and organizing regular activities for college/young professionals for the purpose of fun, community and spiritual growth.

COMMUNITY LIFE

608 PRAYER TEAM

The 608 Prayer Team is responsible for praying fervently, organizing and leading prayer, along with encouraging spiritual growth through daily prayer.

STARTING POINT

Starting point is designed to be a safe place for people who have questions about faith and Christianity. Geared toward people who are beginning their journey with Jesus, Starting Point helps each person find their place in His Story by connecting them with a mentor who helps guide them as they explore God's story together. Starting point is a 6 week journey between 1-3 new followers of Jesus and 1 Mentor.

STARTING POINT MENTOR 3-5 hours per wk (6 wk intervals)

The Starting point mentor guides, directs, teaches and encourages individuals or small groups of new followers of Jesus through a 6 week journey in the grand story of God. The mentor plans each meeting time, seeks answers to questions, prays with and encourages new believers as they begin their journey with Christ. Each mentor will guide no more than 3 followers at a time. All mentorships are gender specific.

CREATIVE ARTS

CREATIVE ARTS MINISTRY

Our mission as the Creative Arts Ministry is to lead others into uncompromised worship of God. We desire to reflect the likeness of Jesus by growing and maturing through personal worship, prayer, study, fellowship and transparency. Our purpose is to give God the glory, honor and praise that He deserves.

VOCAL/BAND

PRAISE TEAM VOCALIST

6hrs/wk

The praise team members help lead the congregation in weekly worship. They must be able to vocally blend well with a group of singers, harmonize by ear and discern sharp and flat singing as well as sing a melody by ear. (Audition required)

CHOIR MEMBER

as needed

The choir helps lead the congregation in worship.

BAND MEMBER

6hrs/wk

The band members help lead the congregation in weekly worship. They must be able to discern "in tune" vs "out of tune", have a trained ear, play their instrument smoothly and proficiently and maintain rhythm with others.

CHILDREN'S CHOIR

The Children's Choir is made up of young singers that are in kindergarten through sixth grade. The Children's choir rehearses in the fall for the annual "Christmas at Grace Chapel" event.

CHILDREN'S CHOIR COORDINATOR

3-4hrs/wk Oct. - Dec.

The children's choir coordinator directs the children's choir and works alongside the Creative Arts Pastor for the "Christmas at Grace Chapel" event. This includes running all rehearsals, communicating with parents and any administrative work.

CREATIVE ARTS

CHILDREN'S CHOIR SUPPORT TEAM

2hrs/wk Oct. - Dec.

The Children's choir support team assists the Coordinator during rehearsals and performances providing any help needed.

PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOGRAPHY

SKILLED PHOTOGRAPHER

as needed

Photographers are called to take pictures at different ministry events and must have their own camera.

VIDEOGRAPHER

as needed

Videographers are responsible for operating a video camera during specific ministry events.

CREATIVE ARTS

ART/DANCE/DRAMA

as needed

People gifted in these areas of the arts are called upon for special events, worship nights and occasional Sunday morning services.

A/V TEAM

The audio/visual team helps to create and enhance the environment of worship during the services. Through sound, video, computer and lighting we seek to help maximize a person's ability to worship God and hear His word.

VISUAL MEDIA OPERATOR

4-5hrs/wk

The visual media operators are responsible for setting up and operating the computer system that feeds the video screens in the worship center during Sunday morning services and for special events. No experience necessary, all volunteers will be trained.

SOUND BOARD OPERATORS

4-5hrs/wk

The sound board operators are responsible for the setup and operation of all audio equipment in the worship center for Sunday morning services and special events. Experience is helpful, but all volunteers will be trained.

CREATIVE ARTS

SUNDAY MORNING RECORDING OPERATOR

-3hrs/wk

The Sunday morning recording operator is responsible for recording and duplicating the sermon each Sunday morning onto CD's for Wise Words and podcasts.

STAGE/SET CONSTRUCTION TEAM**as needed**

The stage/set construction team is responsible for assisting with the assembly, installation and removal of all set and stage pieces used in the worship center.

The hospitality team helps organize special events for the Creative Arts Ministry throughout the year.

SERVICE FLOW COORDINATOR**as needed**

The service flow coordinator works alongside the senior pastor and creative arts pastor to help direct the flow and transitions during a Sunday morning service.

COMMUNION TEAM**as needed**

The communion team is responsible for setting up communion for the church body.

BAPTISM TEAM**as needed**

The baptism team helps coordinate the logistics of a Baptism during a service.

FRONTLINE MINISTRY

FIRST IMPRESSIONS

You only get one chance to make a first impression. The First Impressions Team at Grace Chapel exists to create an environment that is warm and welcoming to all people, in all walks of life. We are intentional and passionate about our purpose of providing a positive environment for people to take their next step toward Christ.

PARKING TEAM **2 services/month**

The Parking Team greets guests in a friendly manner as they drive into the parking lot. They will serve, rain or shine, to assist guest by directing the traffic flow in and out of the parking lot and navigating guests to open areas.

GREETER TEAM COORDINATOR **1-2 hrs/month**

The Greeter Team Coordinator provides oversight for the entire Greeter Ministry. This person is responsible for scheduling and maintaining Greeter Ministry.

GREETER TEAM LEADER **2 services/month**

The Greeter Team Leader is the point person for two services a month. They will make sure that every area is covered and that the Greeters are in place and have everything needed to carry out their ministry. The Greeter Team Leader will also take part in the Greeter weekly duties.

MAIN ENTRANCE GREETER **2 services/month**

The Main Entrance Greeters welcome each person as they approach the main entrance of our building with a smile and a friendly greeting. They will be available to offer personal assistance when needed or to direct individuals to the Welcome Center where they can receive additional assistance.

FRONTLINE MINISTRY

EVENTS TEAM

EVENTS COORDINATOR **4-5 hrs/month**

The Events Coordinator offers assistance to the staff by organizing and leading a team of volunteers for events.

EVENTS TEAM **as needed**

The Events Team offers assistance to the staff by providing such services as: set up, clean up, shopping, serving of food and decorating for events.

COMMUNICATIONS TEAM

COMMUNICATIONS TEAM LEADER **4+ hrs/month**

The Communications Team Leader organizes and leads a team to enhance church-wide communications.

COMMUNICATIONS TEAM **4 hrs/month**

The Communications Team members work together to help enhance church-wide communications.

COMMON GROUNDS

COMMON GROUNDS COORDINATOR **3-4hrs/week**

The Common Grounds coordinator is responsible for planning, organizing and overseeing the Common Grounds preparation and service before and during services.

COMMON GROUNDS TEAM
